 said party of the second part, the receipt whereof is here-
 by acknowledged, and the said party of the second
 part forever released and discharged therefrom,
 have granted, bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened,
 and confirmed, and by these presents do grant, bargain,
 sell, release, remise, alien and confirm, unto the
 said party of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns
 forever, all the following described lots, pieces or parcels
 of land, situate, lying and being in the Town of Eldora,
 in the County of Douglas, and Territory of Kansas, to
