

This Indenture, Made this first day of June in the
 year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred and sixty-
 Between Louis H. Pfeif and Elizabeth his wife of the
 City of Chicago, Count of Cook, and State of Illinois
 and Charles Duerr of the City of Endora County of
 Douglas and Territory of Kansas parties of the first
 part and Henry Witter of the City of Chicago Count
 of Cook and State of Illinois party of the second part
 Witnesseth that the said parties of the first part
 for and in consideration of Seventy-two Dollars
 in hand paid by the said party of the second
 part (the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 and the said party of the second part forever re-
 leased and discharged therefrom) have granted,
 bargained, sold, remised, released, aliened,
 and confirmed, and by these presents do grant,
 bargain, sell, remise release alien, and confirm
 unto the said party of the second part and to
 his heirs and assigns forever all the following de-
 scribed lots, pieces, or parcels of land, situated, lying
 and being in the Town of Endora, in the County of
 Douglas and the Territory of Kansas, to wit:
 Lot Fourteen (14) in Block One hundred and Twenty eight (128)
 Lot Eight (8) in Block Seven & six (76)
 Lot Ten (10) in Block One hundred and Twenty six (126)
 Lot Ten (10) in Block Two hundred and Three (203)
 as described in map of Endora and filed in the
 Recorder's Office of said Douglas County
 Together with all and singular the hereditaments
 and appurtenances therunto belonging, or in any wise
 appertaining, the reversion and reversions, remainder
 and remainders, rents, issues and profits thereof; and all
 the estate, right, title, interest claim or demand what-
 soever of the said parties of the first part, either in
 law or equity, firm and to the above bargained premises,
 with the hereditaments and appurtenances
