

This Indenture, Made this First day of June,
in the year of our Lord One thousand eight hundred
and Sixty, Between Louis W. Pfeif and Elisabeth,
his wife, of the City of Chicago, County of Cook, and
State of Illinois, and Charles Querr, of the City of
Eudora, County of Douglas, and Territory of
Kansas, party of the second part; Witnesseth, That
the said parties of the first part, for and in con-
sideration of Eighty Dollars, in hand paid
by the said party of the second part, the receipt
whereof is hereby acknowledged, and the said
party of the second part forever released and dis-
charged therefrom, have granted, bargained, sold,
remised, released, aliened and confirmed, and
by these presents do grant, bargain, sell, remise
release, alien and confirm unto the said party
of the second part, and to his heirs and assigns
forever, all the following described lots, pieces
or parcels of land, situate, lying and being in
the Town of Eudora, in the County of Douglas,
and Territory of Kansas, to wit:

Lot Fourteen $\frac{1}{4}$ in Block One hundred and
Thirty four $\frac{1}{34}$, Lot Two $\frac{1}{2}$ in Block One hun-
dred and Fifteen $\frac{1}{15}$, Lot Two $\frac{1}{2}$ in Block
One hundred and Thirty six $\frac{1}{36}$, as described
on map of Eudora, and filed in the Recorders
Office of said Douglas County. Together with
all and singular the hereditaments and
appurtenances, thereunto belonging, or in
any wise appertaining; and the reversion
and reversions, remainders and remainders,
rents issues, and profits thereof, and all the
estate, right, title, interest, claim or demand
what soever of the said parties of the first
part, either in law or equity, of, in and to
the above bargained premises, with the
