

bargained sold and quit claimed and by these Presents do bargain
sell and quit claim unto the said J. T. Yonker his heirs executors
administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest
claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and
lying in the town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas to wit Lot numbered
eighty six (86) in Kentucky New York street. This being a
duplicate deed a former deed to said Yonker supposed to be lost
to Haro and to Casey the same with all the privileges and appurten-
ances thereto belonging forever. And I O. E. Larnard do hereby
covenant with the said J. T. Yonker his heirs executors administrators
and assigns that I and my heirs executors and administrators shall
and will warrant defend the said premises to him and them against
the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by from or under
us. And hereby bind myself and my heirs firmly to make ^{over} to said
J. T. Yonker his heirs and assigns any further title I may acquire
to said lot. In witness whereof have hereunto set my hand and
