 therunto belonging forever And Catharine M. Wood do hereby  
 covenant with the said Brown & Harris their heirs executors  
 administrators and assigns; that I and my heirs executors and  
 administrators shall and will warrant and defend the said  
 premises to him and them against the lawful claims  
forward
