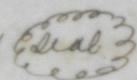

And I the said Symon Allen heirs executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the said John W Still his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right of title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office.
