Lot number Ten (10) on Delaware Street
 To have and to hold the above described
 premises with the privileges and appurtenances
 therunto belonging unto the said Mittabrik, his
 heirs and assigns forever. And I the said
 Cracklin for myself and my heirs executors
 and administrators, do covenant with the said
 Mittabrik his heirs and assigns that the said
 premises are free from all encumbrances made
 or suffered by me that I have full right and
 power to sell convey and quit-claim the same
 and that I shall aid and assist Warrant and defend
 the same unto the said Mittabrik, his heirs and
 assigns forever, against the lawful claims and
 demands of all persons claiming by, through or under
 me but against none other. And I the said
 Joseph Cracklin my heirs executors and administrato-
 tors are held and firmly bound by these presents
 in the sum of One hundred Dollars to the said
 Henry Mittabrik his heirs and assigns to make
 and convey unto him or them all further right
 or title which shall or may be awarded or
 conveyed to me by any authority or by any
forward
