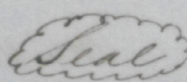

Know all men by these Presents, that I, Lyman
Allen of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas
for and in consideration of the sum of One thousand
Dollars to me in hand paid by Alonso Fuller of
the same place the receipt whereof is hereby
acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit-
claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell
and quit-claim unto the said Alonso Fuller and to
his heirs and assigns forever, all my right title
estate interest claim and demand in possession
or in expectancy of, in and to the following described
land situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid
to wit: Lots number thirty one (31) on
Lawrence Street and One hundred two (102)
on New York Street. To have and to hold
the above described premises with the privileges
and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the
said Alonso Fuller his heirs and assigns forever. And I
the said Lyman Allen for myself and my heirs executors
and administrators do covenant with the said
Alonso Fuller his heirs and assigns that the said
premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered
by me, that I have full right and power to sell
convey and quitclaim the same, and that I shall
and will warrant and defend the same unto
the said Fuller his heirs and assigns forever
against the lawful claims and demands of all
persons.
