Know all men by these Presents That I,  
Ino. P. Wood, of the Town of Leavenworth Territory  
of Kansas for and in consideration of the sum of  
Five Thousand Twenty Dollars to me in hand paid  
by E. D. Ladd of Lawrence said Territory the  
receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained  
sold and quit-claimed and by these presents do  
bargain sell and quit-claim unto the said Ladd  
and to his heirs and assigns forever, all my right  
title estate interest claim and demand, in  
privision or in expectancy of, in and to the following  
described land situated in the Town of Lawrence  
aforesaid to wit: All the interest which I have in  
the said Town of Lawrence in Town lots as described  
in the deed to said Wood from the Trustees of the  
said Town of Lawrence dated July 1<sup>st</sup> 1855 to have and  
to hold the above described premises with the  
privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging unto  
the said Ladd his heirs and assigns forever. And  
I the said Ino. P. Wood for myself and my heirs  
executors and administrators do covenant with the  
said Ladd his heirs and assigns that the said  
premises are free from all encumbrances made or  
suffered by me that I have full right and power  
to sell convey and quit-claim the same, And  
that I shall and will warrant and defend the  
same unto the said Ladd his heirs and assigns  
forever, against the lawful claims and demands  
forward.
