Miller of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas
am held and firmly bound unto Henry Martin
of the same place in the sum of Fifteen hundred
Dollars lawful money of the United States to be paid
to the said Henry Martin his executors, administra-
tors, or assigns; for which payment well and truly
to be made I bind myself my heirs executors and
administrators firmly by these presents.

Sealed with my seal, dated the fourteenth day
of September A. D. 1857. The condition of the
above obligation is such that if the above bounden
Josiah Miller his heirs executors and adminis-
trators shall upon the reasonable request of the
said Henry Martin his heirs assigns executors or
administrators and upon the payment of the sum
of Three Hundred Dollars legal money one year
after date with Twenty per cent Int. by the said Henry
Martin On addition to three hundred dollars this day
paid by said Henry Martin, The receipt whereof
is hereby acknowledged make to said Henry Martin
his heirs assigns a good valid quit claim deed such
as shall then be made in Lawrence conveying to said
Henry Martin his heirs or assigns all of the said
Miller's right title and interest by and to the following
described premises situate in the Town of Lawrence
and Territory of Kansas and known on the Lithographed
Map of said Town, as surveyed and numbered by
