Wood & Co. our heirs executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Six hundred dollars to the said Henry H. Martney his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him & them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to us by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue of a title to the same in Lawrence aforesaid rising from the General Land office.
