Fifty seven (57) and one hundred seventy two (172)
New York Street - One hundred seventy (170) Massa-
chusetts Street. And thirty nine (39) New Jersey Street
To have and To hold the above described premises
with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging

my heirs executors and administrators do covenant
