Lum of Lawrence Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained sold and quit-claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit-claim unto the said S. T. Lum his heirs executors administrators and assigns forever, all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey made by A. O. Searl A. D. 1854 tract Lots nos. One Hundred and sixty six and one hundred and sixty eight (166 & 168) Ohio St. and Lots one hundred & forty nine & one hundred & fifty three (149 & 153) Tennessee St. And I Henry Kepp aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to said S. T. Lum aforesaid his heirs executors administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him & them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence or from any power or person or persons whomever & any and all of the above described property. To have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging forever.
