 And we the said A K & Jane L Burditt our heirs and
 assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents in
 the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said James
 O'Legate his heirs executors and administrators to
 make and convey unto him or them all further right
 or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to
 us by any authority or by any person or persons, by
 virtue of a title to the Town Site of Lawrence aforesaid being
 from the general Land office In witness whereof we have
