sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said Eloman
Allen his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto
him & them all further right or title which shall be
may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by
any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the Town site of
Lawrence aforesaid, issuing from the General Land Office In
Witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal
this 29th day of September A.D. 1857.
