 bind myself my heirs executors and administrators firmly
 by these presents - Sealed with my seal dated this Thirtieth day
 of September A.D. 1857 - The condition of the above obligation
 is such that if the above bounded F. W. Spar shall well and
 truly pay or cause to be paid to the said Joseph H.
 Jones and Mary Jones their heirs or assigns the sum of Four
 Hundred and Twenty two Dollars and the interest thereon
 in the manner following, that is to say, the sum of Two
 Hundred Dollars and the interest from this date at the rate
 of Eight per cent per annum on the first day of January
 next and the further sum of Two Hundred Twenty
 five dollars and the interest as aforesaid on the first
 day of April next which said payments are secured
 by Indenture of Mortgage of from date hereunto executed
 by said F. W. Spar to said Joseph H. Jones and Mary
 Jones upon Lot Number Fifty one (51) in Vermont
 Street in said Town of Lawrence then this obligation shall
