all persons, claiming by, through, or under me but against
none other. And I the said William O. Donnell my heirs
executors, and administrators are held and firmly bound
by these presents, in the sum of One Thousand Dollars
to the said Joseph L. McCubbin his heirs and assigns, to
make and convey unto him or them, all further right or
title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any
authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the
town site of Lawrence aforesaid, issuing from the General
Land office in witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand
and seal this 2nd day of October A.D. 1857.
