to me in hand paid by Babcock & Liskins of Lawrence
Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged, have bargained
sold and quitclaimed and by these do bargain sell and quit claim
unto the said Babcock & Liskins their heirs, executors, administrators
and assigns forever, all my right, title, interest, claim, and
demand in and to the following described land, situate and
lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas
according to the survey made by A. D. Searl A.D. 1830, to wit:
Thirty four (34.) feet front off of the south side of Lot
number twenty seven (27) Massachusetts Street Lawrence K. T.
and I Samuel et Wood aforesaid my heirs, executors, adminis-
trators and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these
presents in the sum of Sixteen Hundred Dollars to the
said Babcock & Liskins aforesaid their heirs, executors
administrators and assigns, to will and duly make over
and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive
from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from
any person, in person, in personas wheresoever, to any and all
of the above described property. To Have and to Hold the
same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging
