 Twenty nine in New Hampshire Street: Lots Number (117)  
 One Hundred and Sixteen and (19) One Hundred and  
 Sixteen in Pennsylvania Street: Lots Number (284) Two  
 Hundred and Eighty four and (286) Two Hundred and Eighty  
 six in Mississippi Street: Lot Number (167) One Hundred and  
 Sixty seven in Tennessee Street: Lot Number (178) one hundred  
 and twenty eight in New York Street according to the survey and
