in hand paid by Stillman Blood of the same place the receipt  
whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold, and quit  
claimed, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the  
said Blood his heirs executors, administrators, and assigns  
forever, all my right, title, interest, claim and demand in and  
to the following described land situate and lying in the Town  
of Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas according to the survey  
made by A. D. Searl A. D. 1854. to wit: Lot Number Fifty two  
(52) Ohio Street And I, G. C. Brackett aforesaid my heirs  
executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound  
by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to  
said Blood aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and  
assigns, to well and truly make over and convey unto him  
or them all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of  
the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or persons  
whomsoever, to any and all of the above described property so  
have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances
