This Indenture made this seventh day of July A.D. 1855. between Samuel S. Snyder, Joel Gruber, John P. Wood, William A. D. Lykins, George W. Hutchinson Trustees of the Town Site of Lawrence Kansas Territory, parties of the first part and Joseph D. Boyer party of the second part, Witnesseth that in compliance with the provisions contained in the Deed in Trust from me William A. D. Lykins to the above Trustees creating said Trustees and in consideration of the sum of One Dollar in hand paid by Joseph D. Boyer of the said Town and Territory the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have conveyed, released and quitclaimed unto the said party of the second part his heirs and assigns, all right, title and interest in and to a certain lot of land situated and being in Lawrence First Council District Kansas Territory, and designated on the Lithographed Chart as surveyed by A. D. Searl October A.D. 1854. as follows: To wit Lot, Indiana Street Two Hundred twelve (212). To Have and to Hold the aforesaid quitclaimed

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
