 of Lawrence Kansas the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents
 do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Babcock &
 Lykins their heirs executors administrators and assigns
 from all my right title interest claim and demand in
 and to the following described land situate and lying
 in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas
 according to the survey made by A D Searl ad 1854,
 to wit: Lot Number Seventeen Massachusetts Street.
 And I the Hunt aforesaid my heirs executors administrators
 and assigns, are held and firmly bound by these presents
 in the sum of Six Thousand Dollars to said Babcock
 & Lykins aforesaid their heirs executors administrators and
 assigns, or their and firmy bound by these, to will
 and duly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of
 the said Town of Lawrence, or from any power, or person or
 persons whomsoever, to any and all of the above described
 property I do Have and to Hold the same, with all the
 privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
