with our seals dated this seventeenth day of October ad 1857.
The condition of this obligation is such that if the said
Babcock & Lykins shall make ready and deliver unto the
said Joseph D Boyer (provided the said Joseph D Boyer
shall in or before the first day of March 1858. pay to the
said Babcock & Lykins a certain note bearing even date herewith
for Two Hundred and Fifty Dollars with interest at the rate
of five per cent per month - dated Oct. 17th 1857. payable
on the first day of March ad 1858.) a good and sufficient
just claim of Lot - Standard Forty Seven in New
Hampshire Street in the Town of Lawrence Kansas, then
this obligation to be null and void otherwise to remain in
full force and effect - In testimony whereof we have hereunto
set our hands and seals on this seventeenth day of October
ad 1857.
