The receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quit claim'd, and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim, unto the said Barker and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title estate, interest claim and demand, in possession or in expectation of in and to the following described land situated in the Town of Lawrence, aforesaid, Court, Lot Number One Hundred & Two (102) on Delaware Street. To have and to hold the above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Barker and to his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Blanton for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators, do covenant with the said Barker his heirs and assigns, that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Barker his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by, through, or under me but against none other. And I the said Francis M. Blanton my heirs executors, and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the said Ingle Barker his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them, all further right or title which shall or may be awarded to me by any authority or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the premises of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land Office.
