And I the said James F Legato my heirs executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the said Abraham and John Watts their heirs and assigns to make and answer unto them all further rights or title which shall or may be awarded or annexed to me by any authority or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office.
