

Richmond Brooks of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quitclaimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto the said P Richmond Brooks his heirs executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right title interest claim and demand in and to the following described land situate and lying in the Lawrence in the Territory of Kansas to wit: Lot Number One hundred Sixty Eight (168.) on Indiana Street - And I E D Ladd aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to said P Richmond Brooks aforesaid my heirs executors, administrators and assigns to well and truly make over and convey unto him of them all the title which I shall receive from the trustees of the town site of Lawrence aforesaid or of any other person or persons to me and all of the above described
