


"Brought forward"

 me but against none other. And I the Chancery C. Baird and  
 my heirs executors, and administrators are held and firmly  
 bound by these presents in the sum of Three Hundred and Ninety  
 Dollars to the said John Ell Coe and his heirs and assigns  
 to make and convey unto him or them, all further right or  
 title which shall be may be awarded or conveyed to me by my  
 authority or by any power or persons by virtue of a bill of the  
 town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General

 and seal this Third day of November A.D. 1857.


