

Know all men by these Presents. That I  
 Samuel W Wood of the Town of Lawrence County  
 of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum of  
 Five Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by  
 W B Walling of the same place the receipt whereof  
 is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and  
 quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and  
 quit claim unto the said W B Walling and to his  
 heirs and assigns forever all right title Estate interest  
 claim and demand, in possession or in expectancy of  
 in and to the following described land situated  
 in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Lots  
 Number Eighty nine (89.) and Lot Number Ninety  
 one Tennessee Street. To have and to hold the above  
 described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances  
 thereunto belonging unto the said W B Walling his  
 and assigns forever. And I the said Samuel W Wood  
 for myself and my heirs executors and administrators  
 do covenant with the said W B Walling his heirs and  
 assigns that the said premises are free from all  
 encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have  
 full right and power to sell convey and quit claim  
 the same and that I shall and will warrant and  
 defend the same unto the said W B Walling my  
 heirs and assigns forever, against lawful claims and  
 demands of all persons, claiming by, through or under  
 me but against none others. And I the said W B.  
 Walling my heirs executors and administrators  
 are held and firmly bound by these presents in  
 the sum of One Thousand Dollars to the  
 said W B Walling his heirs and assigns to  
 make and convey unto him or them all further right  
which shall or may be awarded or granted to me by any authority or by any power of attorney  
in the year 1826 to the true title of Lawrence aforesaid  
 issuing from the General Land Office. In witness
