


Know all men by these Presents That I John

 to me in hand paid by William Scott of the Town and
 Territory aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged
 have bargained sold and quit claimed and by these presents do
 bargain sell and quitclaim unto the said William Scott his heirs
 executors, administrators and assigns forever all my right title
 interest claim and demand in and to the following described
 land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the
 Territory of Kansas according to the survey made
 by A. D. Stark ad 1854. to wit: Lot No 29 in Ohio Street
 Lot No 16 in Kentucky Street Lot No 80 in Ohio Street
 Lot No 108 New York Street Lot No 55 Rhode Island Street
 Lot No 101 Connecticut Street Lot No 49 in Pinkney Street
 Lot No 11 in New Jersey Street Lot 150. in Vermont Street.
 Lot 126 in Kentucky Street Lot No 5 in Delaware St.
 Lot No. 36. in Louisiana Street. And I John P. Wood
 aforesaid my heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 are held and firmly bound by these presents, in
 the sum of One Thousand Dollars to William Scott
 aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns
 shall and truly make over and convey unto him or them
 all the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said
 Town of Lawrence or from any person or persons whom
 soever, to have and all of the above described property to
 have and to hold the same with all the franchises and
 appurtenances therunto belonging forever. In witness

 Thirtieth day of January ad 1856.
