 and quitclaim the same, and that I shall and will warrant  
 and defend the same unto the said Edward Winslow  
 his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims  
 and demands of all persons, claiming by through or under  
 him back against me other. And I the said Samuel Kimball  
 my heirs, executors, and administrators are held and firmly  
 bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred  
 Dollars to the said Edward Winslow his heirs and  
 assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further  
 rights of title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed  
 to me by any authority or by any person or persons  
 by virtue of a title to the Townsite of Lawrence aforesaid  
 issuing from the General Land Office. In witness whereof
