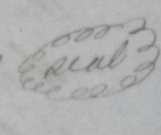


Know all Men by these Presents That I J. T. Yunker

 convey unto him or them a good and valid title such
 as I shall receive from the Trustees of the Town
 aforesaid To Have and to hold the same with all the

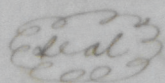
