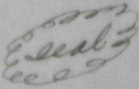


Know all men by these Presents That I J. L. Crane

 claim unto the J. T. Yunkes his heirs ^{executors & administrators} and assigns forever
 all right title interest claim and demand in and to
 the following described land, situate and lying in the Town
 of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas according to the
 survey made by A. C. Saul A. D. 1854. to wit: Lot number
 One Hundred and ten (110) and One Hundred and twelve
 (112) Delaware Street. Town of Lawrence Territory of
 Kansas. and J. L. Crane aforesaid my heirs executors
 administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound
 by these presents in the sum of One Hundred (\$100) Dollars
 to the said J. T. Yunkes aforesaid his heirs executors administrators
 and assigns, to well and truly make war and convey unto
 him or them all the title which I shall receive from the
 Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from any person
 or persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described
 property to have and to hold the same, with all the
 privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever.
