And I the said Wilder Knight my heirs, executors, and administrators, are holden firmly bound by these presents, in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars, to the said Coffey his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further rights of title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any authority or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid, issuing from the General Land Office.
