

Know all men by these Presents That we Francis
 & Bailey and Henry Muzzey of the Town of Lawrence
 Territory of Kansas. for and in consideration of the sum of
 One Hundred and fifty Dollars to us in hand paid by Richard
 G. Haif of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby ack-
 nowledged have bargained, sold and quit claimed, and by these
 Presents do bargain, sell and quit claim, unto the said Haif and
 to his heirs and assigns forever all our right title Estate
 interest, claim and demands, in possession or in expectancy
 of, in and to the following described land, situated in the
 Town of Lawrence, aforesaid, to wit: Being Lot number
 One hundred Eighty two (No 182) on Indian Street
 according to the Plat of said town as surveyed and drawn
 by A. D. Seal October 1854. To have and to hold the
 above described premises, with the privileges and appurtenances
 therunto belonging, unto the said Haif his heirs and assigns
 forever. And we the said Bailey & Muzzey for ourselves and
 our heirs, executors and administrators do covenant with
 the said Haif his heirs and assigns that the said premises
 are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by us that we
 have full right and power to sell, convey and quit claim
 the same, and that no shall any will warrant and defend
 the same unto the said Haif his heirs and assigns forever, against
 the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by
 though, or under us but against none other. And we the
 said Francis & Bailey & Henry Muzzey our heirs executors
 and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these Presents
 in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to the said Richard G.
 Haif his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them
 all further rights of title which shall or may be awarded or
 or conveyed by us by any authority or by any person or persons
 by virtue of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid, issuing
 from the General Land office. In witness whereof we have here-

 A. D. 1857.
