 of the town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas for and in
 Consideration of the sum of Three Hundred Dollars to me
 in hand paid by George C Chandler of Lawrence aforesaid
 the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained
 sold and quit claimed and by these Presents do bargain sell
 and quit claim unto the said Chandler and his heirs
 and assigns forever, all my right title Estate, interest
 claim and demands, in possession or in Expectancy of
 in and to the following described land, situated in the
 Town of Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Being Lots Numbered
 One Hundred and Sixty seven & One Hundred and Seventy two
 (Nos 167 & 172.) in Mississippi Street - Do have and hold
 hold the above described premises, with the privileges and
 appurtenances therunto belonging unto the said Chandler his
 heirs and assigns forever, and I the said Baldwin for myself
 and my heirs executors and administrators, do covenant
 with the said Chandler his heirs and assigns that the said
 premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by
 me that have full right and power to sell convey and
 the same and that I shall and will warrant and defend
 the same unto the said Chandler his heirs and assigns forever
 against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming
 by through, or under me but against none other. And I the
 said Baldwin my heirs executors and administrators
 are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of
 Three Hundred Dollars to said Chandler his heirs and
 assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further
 rights or title which shall or may be awarded of or conveyed
 by me by any authority or by any person or persons by virtue
 of a title to the town site of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from
 the General Land office. In witness whereof I have hereunto
