To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said D. W. Hallingford his heirs and assigns forever. And I the said Samuel W. Hood for myself and my heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said D. W. Hallingford his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and defend the same unto the said Hallingford his heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by through or under me but against none other. And I the said Samuel W. Hood my heirs executors and administrators are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Two Hundred Dollars to the said Hallingford his heirs and assigns, to make and convey unto him or them all further right of title which shall or may be
