Know all men by these Presents that we Moore Brothers of the Town of Lawrence Territory of Kansas. for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars to us in hand paid by Vergil W. Kimball of Lawrence aforesaid the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained sold and quitclaimed and by these Presents do bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Kimball and to his heirs and assigns forever all my right title Estate interest claim and demand in possession or in expectancy of, in and to the following described land situated in the Town of Lawrence aforesaid to wit: Lots numbers thirty five (35) on Nag Seney Street and One Hundred twenty two (122) on Illinois Street. To have and to hold the above described premises with the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging unto the said Kimball and to his heirs and assigns forever, and we the said Moore Brothers for ourselves and each of our heirs executors and administrators do covenant with the said Kimball his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all Encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quitclaim the same and that I shall and will Warrant and Defend the same unto the said Kimball his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by through or under me but against none other. And we said Moore Brothers our and each of our heirs executors and administrators do hereby and firmly bring by these Presents in the sum of Five hundred Dollars to the said V. W. Kimball his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to forward
