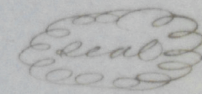

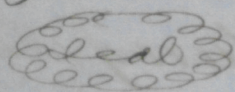

Witnesseth that the said party of the first part for and in consideration of the sum of One Hundred Dollars lawful money of the United States to him in hand paid by the said party of the second part as is before the sealing and delivery of these presents the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have remised released and quit claimed unto the said party of the second part and to his heirs and assigns forever all that certain piece or parcel of land lying and being situated in the town of Lawrence in the County of Douglas and Territory of Kansas known on the plan of said Town as Lots Number Eighty and Eighty two, situated on Connecticut Street together with all and singular the tenements hereditaments and appurtenances
