 bargain, sell and quit claim unto the said Silas Green his
 heirs executors administrators, and assigns forever all our
 right title interest claim and demand in and to the following
 described land situate and lying in the town of Lawrence
 Territory of Kansas, to wit: Lot Numbering forty (40) on
 New Hampshire Street. To have and to hold the same with
 all the privileges and appurtenances therunto belonging forever
 unto the said John Hawes and William P. Tapp to their heirs
 and assigns; that we and our heirs, executors and administrators
 shall and will warrant and defend the said premises to him
 and them against the lawful claims and demands of all persons
 claiming by from or under us, and we hereby bind ourselves
 and our heirs firmly in the sum of Two thousand Dollars
 to make good to said Silas Green his heirs and assigns all
 further title which we may acquire to said premises. In
