



And I the said Joseph Cracklin for myself and my heirs, executors and administrators do command unto the said David Upham his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey and quich claim the same and that I shall and will Answer and Defend the same unto the said Upham, his heirs and assigns forever against the lawful claims and demands of all persons, claiming by through of under me but against none other. And I the said Joseph. Cracklin my heirs executors, and administrators are held and family bound by these presents in the sum of Three Hundred Dollars by said David Upham his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them all further rights of title which shall or may be awarded to me by any authority or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the same set of Lawrence aforesaid issuing from the General Land office.
