


"Brought forward"

Duncans their heirs and assigns forever, as aforesaid; and that I will and my heirs executors and administrators shall warrant and defend the same to the said Duncans their heirs and assigns forever, against the lawful claims and demands of all persons. Provided nevertheless, that if the said Collamore his heirs executors, or administrators shall pay unto the said Duncans their executors administrators, or assigns the sum of One Hundred Dollars, in four months from this date with interest at the rate of five per cent per month, then this Deed, as also a certain promissory note bearing even date with these presents, signed by the said Collamore whereby he promises to pay the said Duncans the sum and interest of the time aforesaid, shall both be absolutely void to all intents and purposes. In witness whereof I the said Geo W Collamore have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of November in the year of Our Lord eighteen hundred and fifty seven.
