Provided nevertheless, that if the said Callamore his heirs executors, or administrators shall pay unto the said Duncans their executors administrators, or assigns the sum of One Hundred Dollars in four months from this date with interest at the rate of five per cent per month - then this Deed, as also a certain promissory note bearing even date with these presents, signed by the said Callamore whereby he promises to pay the said Duncans the said sum and interest at the time aforesaid, shall to the be absolutely void to all intents and purposes - In Witness Whereof I the said Geo W Callamore - have hereunto set my hand and seal this twenty fifth day of November in the year of Our Lord Eighteen hundred and fifty seven
