S. S. Kimball their heirs or assigns, by which payment will
and truly to be made we bind ourselves and our successors by these
present. Now the condition of this obligation is such, that if
upon the payment by the said party of the second part of all taxes
lawfully assessed upon the aforesaid premises the said parties of
the first, or their successors, shall make and deliver unto the said
party of the second part, his heirs or assigns, a good and valid
Deed with the usual covenants for conveyance in fee simple
whence a patent for the Trin Site of Lawrence shall issue from
Congress unto one Robert Robitaille or William H. R. Lykins
and be conveyed unto the aforesaid trustees then this obligation shall
be void and of no effect, otherwise to remain in full force. In
