 full title to such real or personal property in my name in
 the same manner as I myself do if present, and I do hereby
 ratify and sanction all lawful acts done by my said attorney in said

 A.D. 1854 To wit Lot No One Hundred and Sixty Three
 (113) New Hampshire Street. And I Turner Sampson
 aforesaid my heirs executors administrators and assigns and assigns
 are held and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of Three
 Hundreds Dollars to said Elisha B. Ostrom aforesaid his heirs
