 release convey and confirm unto the said party of the second part
 mes to his heirs and assigns forever all the following described
 situated in the Town of Lawrence Kansas Territory, to wit;
 the South one half of lot number eighteen (18) th Vennif Street
 together with all and singular the hereditaments and appurtenances
 therunto belonging, or in any wise appertaining, both in law and
 equity. This Grant is intended as a Mortgage to secure the payment
 of the sum of Ninety six Dollars $\frac{1}{2}$ $\frac{1}{2}$ in one Month from
 forward.
