And the said Margarita Hancock, wife of the said Benjamin J Hancock being of lawful age, and having hereby me separate and apart from her said husband, examined and the full contents of the said Deed being made known and explained to her, acknowledges that she executed the same, and relinquished her dower to the lands and tenements therein mentioned voluntarily, and of her own free will and accord did seal and as the act and deed, deliver the said conveyance without any exception in the part of the said husband - In witness whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal at the County of Douglas this 19<sup>th</sup> twenty ninth day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight -
