And the said Margaretta Hancock, wife of the said Benjamin S Hancock being of lawful age, and having been by me separate and apart from her said husband, examined and the full contents of the said Deed being made known and explained to her, acknowledged that she executed the same, and relinquished her dower to the lands and tenements therein mentioned voluntarily, and of her own free will and accord did seal and as the act and deed, deliver the said conveyance without any coercion in the part of the said husband - In Witness Whereof, I have hereunto set my hand and seal at the County of Douglas this (29th) twenty ninth day of January in the year one thousand eight hundred and fifty eight -
