 sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim unto  
 the said G W Brown & J L Brown their heirs executors administrators and  
 assigns forever, all my rights title interest claim, and demands in and to the following  
 described land situate and lying in the Town of Lawrence, in the Territory of Kansas  
 according to the survey made by A C Seal A D 1854. South the North  
 half of Lot Number Fifty three (53) on Massachusetts Street. And William  
 H R Lykins aforesaid his heirs, executors, administrators and assigns are held  
 and firmly bound by these presents in the sum of One thousand Dollars  
 to said G W & J L Brown aforesaid their heirs, executors, administrators  
 and assigns to will and truly make over and convey unto him or them all  
 the title which I shall receive from the Trustees of the said Town of Lawrence, or from  
 any power or person or persons whomever to any and all of the above described property  
 to have and to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances therunto
