Kansas according to the Survey made by A S Earle A D 1854 to wit Lat.  
Number Sixty seven (67) in New York Street and Lot Number One hundred  
and three (103) in Connecticut Street And I William H R Sykins aforesaid  
my heirs executors administrators and assigns are held and firmly bound  
by these presents in the sum of One Hundred Dollars to the said Cr James  
Seiby his heirs executors administrators and assigns to will and truly make  
over and convey unto him or them all the title which I shall receive from  
the trustees of the said town of Lawrence or from any power or person or  
persons whomsoever to any and all of the above described property, To have and  
to hold the same with all the privileges and appurtenances thereto belonging
