

Know all Men by these Presents That I E Odads of the  
 Town of Lawrence Executors of Kansas, for and in consideration of the sum  
 of Two Hundred Dollars to me in hand paid by George W Longfellow  
 of the same place the receipt whereof is hereby acknowledged have bargained  
 sold and quit claimed and by these presents do bargain sell and quit claim  
 unto the said Longfellow and to his heirs and assigns forever all my  
 right title Estate, interest, claim and demands in possession or in expectancy  
 of, in and to the following described land, situated in the Town of Lawrence  
 of this, to wit Lot Number Sixty one (61) on Connecticut Street.  
 To have and to hold the above described premises, with the privileges and  
 appurtenances therunto belonging, unto the said Longfellow his heirs  
 and assigns forever. And I the said E Odads for myself and my heirs  
 executors and administrators do covenant with the said George W Longfellow  
 his heirs and assigns that the said premises are free from all encumbrances  
 made or suffered by me that I have full right and power to sell convey  
 and quit claim the same, and that I shall and will warrant and  
 defend the same unto the said Longfellow his heirs and assigns forever  
 against the lawful claims and demands of all persons claiming by  
 through or under but against none other. And I the said Odads my  
 heirs, executors, and administrators, are held and firmly bound by these  
 presents in the sum of Four Hundred Dollars, to the said Longfellow  
 his heirs and assigns to make and convey unto him or them, all further  
 right or title which shall or may be awarded or conveyed to me by any  
 authority, or by any person or persons, by virtue of a title to the town site  
 of Lawrence hereinbefore issuing from the General Land Office, In witness  
 whereof I have hereunto set my hand and seal this Thirtieth day of  
 February A.D. 1858
